### BLACKFORD COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S

#### MEETING October 21, 2019

The Blackford County Commissioners met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. on October 21, 2019 in the Commissioner's Office located on the first floor of the Blackford County Courthouse, Hartford City IN.

<u>President John Lancaster called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance</u> and Deputy Auditor Lisa Simmons called roll with Commissioners Nick Rhodes, John Lancaster and John Oxley present.

The minutes of the October 7, 2019 meeting were approved as presented by a 3/0 vote after a motion by John Oxley and a 2nd by Nick Rhodes.
