The Blackford County Commissioners met in an Emergency Meeting at 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, April 22, 2020 in the Commissioner's office of the Blackford County Courthouse, Hartford City IN.

<u>President John Lancaster called the meeting to order</u> and Auditor Sharon Hartley called roll with Commissioners John Lancaster (on Zoom), Nick Rhodes and John Oxley present. **Others in attendance** in person, Judge Brian Bade. On Zoom were Laura Coons, Tyler Hunt, Warren Brown, Cheri Brown, Sue Kochanek and Jim Forcum.

The sole purpose of the meeting is to approve Resolution 2020-R4, A Resolution of the Blackford County Commissioners to Create a Policy in Compliance with the Families First Coronavirus Response Act and the Executive Orders of Indiana Governor Eric Holcomb.
