2020 Budget Workshop #2 August 7, 2019

The Blackford County Council met at 6:19 p.m. on the first floor of the Blackford County Courthouse located at 110 W Washington Street, Hartford City, Indiana for the regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, August 7, 2019.

President Dan Borgenheimer called the meeting to order.

The Council decided to fund the 4-H and Senior Citizens assistance at 75% from EDIT and 25% from County General Commissioners budgets. 4-H - \$2,500 from Commissioners and \$7,500 from EDIT. Senior Citizens - \$3,000 from Commissioners and \$9,000 from EDIT.


The 2020 Blackford County Solid Waste District budget was presented for Council review. This budget will be reviewed at the August 21 public hearing and adopted on September 4.

There being no further comment Kyle Lechien made the motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:48 p.m. with a second by Karen Mealy and carried 7/0.


