MEETING December 21, 2020

The Blackford County Commissioners met in regular session at 8:38 a.m. on December 21, 2020 in the Commissioner's office on the first floor of the Blackford County Courthouse, Hartford City IN. The meeting was available on Zoom as well.

<u>President John Lancaster called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance</u> and Auditor Sharon Hartley called roll with Commissioners John Oxley, John Lancaster and Nick Rhodes present **Others in attendance in person** were Bruce Edgington, Anne Owen, Jeff Sones, Tim Stanley, Jon Oswalt, Sam Swenson, Paul Schriver, Bill Smith, Laura Coons, Kim Pitts and Glen Felver. **Attending on Zoom** were Tyler Hunt, Kelly Cale, Nick Rhodes, Dr. Tom Lee and Robin Cale.

The minutes of the December 7, 2020 Regular meeting were approved as Presented by a 3/0 vote after a motion by John Oxley and a 2nd by Nick Rhodes.

Dr. Tom Lee reported that he and his wife will be heading up the 2021 Heritage Days planned for May. There is a need for funding. Lee was advised to talk to the county council in January.

Highway Supervisor Bruce Edgington reported the highway department received the new backhoe on the 11^{th} and worked with it on the 14^{th} . Everything went well.

Veteran's Affairs Officer Jon Oswalt said the state has set rules for VA Officers. The must be a veteran and have lived in the county for 2 years. Other rules may apply.

Sheriff Jeff Sones gave the inmate count as 23 local males, 6 local females, 12 out of county males and 4 out of county females for a total of 45 inmates.

Outgoing Clerk Laura Coons thanked the Commissioners, Council, Department Heads and voters for 23 years of help and support. Commissioners thanked Coons for her service.

The Health Department requested permission to apply for grants to help with the pandemic. John Oxley made a motion to allow them to apply for grants. Nick Rhodes 2^{nd} and the vote was 3/0.

Local resident Glenn Felver gave his resume for building inspector and gave a brief rundown of his experience in the field.
