November 17, 2022 Special Meeting

The Blackford County Council met at 6:30 p.m. on the first floor of the Blackford County Courthouse located at 110 W Washington Street, Hartford City, Indiana for a Special meeting on Thursday, November 17, 2022. The meeting was also available on Zoom.

Dan Borgenheimer called the Special Meeting to order, and Auditor Sharon Hartley called roll. The topic of discussion was cuts needed to the County General Fund for the 2023 budget. The Department of Local Government Finance's 1782 Notice shows County General proposed expenses over revenue by \$79,485.

Many options were discussed but no decisions on cuts were made.

The council decided to ask County General department heads to review their 2023 budgets and see if they can make any cuts. The auditor will send an email to department heads along with their 2023 budget detailing the council request. The department response is due back to the auditor by December 19th for council to review for the December 21st meeting.


There being no further comment President Borgenheimer adjourned the meeting at 7:25 p.m. on a motion by Karen Mealy and 7/0 vote.




